

Billing Policy and Fee Schedule

This policy is designed to provide low-cost or free medical services to patients who have no means, or limited means, to pay for their medical services (Uninsured or Underinsured). This policy does not apply to those services or equipment that are purchased from external providers and vendors, including reference laboratory testing, medications from the pharmacy (either prescription or over-the-counter), and other such services.

All pregnancy tests (urine and/or blood) and obstetrical ultrasounds provided at Obria Medical Clinics of Iowa are free. Pre-conception testing is not included in any pregnancy-related 'free' services.

Obria does bill for sexually transmitted infection (STI) testing and wellness exams. Patients can choose to pay for their services out-of-pocket or have Obria submit a claim to their insurance company. Patients who choose to pay for their services out-of-pocket will be charged based on the following price list:

Treatment for Gonorrhea: \$10

Nurse Visit: \$17.50

Physical exam: \$35

No discount will be given for outside lab fees as these are already at the lowest price we are given by Centers for Disease Detection (CDD). Obria Medical Clinics of Iowa uses CDD for send-out labs.

Obria will not deny care based on an individual's inability to pay.

Obria will provide discounts without regard to age, gender, race, sexual orientation, creed, religion, disability, national origin, etc.

If a patient is unable to cover the cost of their appointment, they will be encouraged to meet with an Obria staff member to find reasonable payment alternatives including, but not limited to, setting up a payment plan.

No payment is required at time of visit.

Patients with an outstanding balance will be either physically or electronically billed. No late fees will be charged for services.

Information relating to payment plans, discounts, and write-offs will be maintained and preserved in the electronic health record, per patient.

Dignity and confidentiality will be respected for all who seek and/or are provided charitable services.
